Insurance class	Description of tax or charge	% (unless otherwise stated)	To be paid by
All classes	SSN levy	0.60	Insured
All classes except PA	Internal tax	0.10	Insured
Non-life (including healthcare but not PA) except workers' compensation	VAT (IVA)	21.00	Insured
All classes	Social services	0.50	Insured
All classes except life	Fire brigade tax	0.32	Insurer
